AWARD OF THE PURPLE HEART

Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45, the Purple Heart for wounds received in action against the enemy is awarded the following named officers and enlisted men:

First Lieutenant CASIMIR S GAFFA, O-28 101, Company I, 7th Cavalry Regiment, 1st Cavalry Division. Wounded in action at Konjiam-Ni, Korea on 10 February 1951. Entered federal service from Wisconsin.

Major CONRAD R UNDERDAHL, O23 523, Headquarters Company, 3rd Battalion, 7th Cavalry Regiment, 1st Cavalry Division. Wounded in action at Konjiam-Ni, Korea on 12 February 1951. Entered federal service from Idaho.

First Lieutenant RICHARD Y ERTSMAN JR., O1 296 345, Company I, 7th Cavalry Regiment, 1st Cavalry Division. Wounded in action at Konjiam-Ni, Korea on 14 February 1951. Entered federal service from Texas.

First Lieutenant DAVID P HUGHES, O62 721, Company K, 7th Cavalry Regiment, 1st Cavalry Division. Wounded in action at Konjiam-Ni, Korea on 14 February 1951. Entered federal service from Colorado.
