MY REACTION TO TODAY'S GAZETTE EDITORIAL

The editorial you reprinted from the Orange County Register on October 29th was juvenile. You headlined it "Long, Costly War Has Harmed Us All" and subtitled it 'Let's be careful to never repeat this.' It reads like a school boy who thinks, by wishing it were so, and writes an essay, all wars will just stop happening.

You are fools if you think, in a world now of 7 Billion people there will not be any more protracted wars or serious attempts by enemies of America and its wealth and freedom, to harm its people, its global presence or destroy it – with nuclear weapons, cyber attacks, or even more deadly weapons of mass destruction.

Forty Four years ago during Vietnam – the war we lost - a small handful of we Army officers in the Pentagon predicted that the future will see many more similar wars in the 3d world – almost all 'Insurgencies' – for ideological, religious, territorial, or resource – food and water - reasons. And they will be prolonged by the ever greater miniaturization of ever deadlier weapons and technologies in the hands of ununiformed rebels.

We were spot on – Iraq and Afghanistan fit our predictions exactly. But we also - and I provided the then Secretary of Defense Robert McNamara as his 'Assistant for Counterinsurgency' - an American strategy for preventing, as well as winning, such protracted wars. That the US has to aid seriously in sustained Development – economic, political, social – in the 3d world wherever festering insurgency breaks out into armed conflict. As well as wisely use our Security – military and clandestine – forces.

In fact in his speech of May 18th 1966 before the Newspaper Editors of North America he said what I shortened to 'Security IS Development.' Read about it yourselves in the May 22d pages of the New York Times. It was repeated in publications around the world. They thought he was running for President. Instead he headed for the World Bank - the preeminent global 'development' organization.

Had not Gen Petreaus and Ambassador Crocker, and Fort Carson's own Colonel -
